In the second year of the middle school's **Academic Personal Best Program**, numbers of student emerged into the program's most ambitious segment – ***Above and Beyond***. Students who score from 90 to 100 percent in a course are encouraged to seek academic challenges beyond the established curriculum while completing their regular course responsibilities. ***Above and Beyond*** projects are usually extensions of coursework, but some students elect to research topics and develop projects in other fields. Upon the completion of projects, students present or display their work, increasing awareness of their research as well as their accomplishments.

Last year, a number of seventh grade students earned awards for their participation in **Above and Beyond**.
