Eligible SB-CEU Offerings—Non-Traditional

****Serving as a Mentor Teacher**

1. Three (3.0) SB-CEUs per semester. The teacher must be placed with one mentor teacher throughout the entire placement period.

****Serving as a Supervising Teacher**

1. Three (3.0) SB-CEUs per a college placement period of not less than eight weeks. The student must be placed with one teacher throughout the entire placement period.

****Serving as a New Administrator Mentor**

1. Three (3.0) SB-CEUs per school year.

*****Serving as a New Principal Mentor**

1. Three (3.0) SB-CEUs per school year.

****Serving as a Supervising School Psychologist**

1. Three (3.0) SB-CEUs per a placement period of not less than eight weeks. The student must be placed with one school psychologist throughout the entire placement period.

****Serving as a Supervising School Counselor**

1. Three (3.0) SB-CEUs per a placement period of not less than eight weeks. The student must be placed with one school counselor throughout the entire placement period.

****Serving on a P.A. 25 School Improvement Team**

1. Three (3.0) SB-CEUs per school year (SB-CEUs are issued for one committee per year).

****Serving on a School Committee**

1. Three (3.0) SB-CEUs per school year (SB-CEUs are issued for one committee per year)

****Serving on an approved Accreditation Review and/or Site Visit Accreditation Team**

1. SB-CEUs for One Day Visits = 2.0
2. SB-CEUs for Two Day Visits = 3.0

****Serving on a State Board Appointed Advisory Committee**

Approval applied for by the Michigan Department of Education only.

****A maximum of 9.0 SB-CEUs earned in each activity in a five-year renewal period can be used toward advanced certificate renewal.**

Conferences

1. Minimum/maximum number of contact hours = 5.0 to 25.0
2. Minimum number of SB-CEUs = 0.5; maximum number of SB-CEUs = 2.5

Non-Conferences

1. Minimum number of contact hours = 3.0
2. Minimum number of SB-CEUs = .3

College Conversion

1. College conversion must be approved by the college/university upon application for SB-CEUs.

IACET CEUs

Conversion to SB-CEUs is completed after the offering has been completed by the participant. The participant provides the original certificate of completion to their local SB-CEU sponsor. IACET CEUs are converted to SB-CEUs on a one-to-one basis.

MVU CEUs

Conversion to SB-CEUs is completed after the offering has been taken and completed by the participant. The participant provides the original certificate of completion to their local SB-CEU sponsor. MVU CEUs are converted to SB-CEUs on a one-to-one basis.
