

**Webberville Community School's Board of Education**  
**Regular Meeting Minutes**  
**March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2007**

This Regular Meeting of the Webberville Board of Education was called to order by President Clifford H. Simmons II, in the Spartan Center Community Room on Monday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2007, at 7:00 p.m.

**Approval of Agenda:**

Ms. Westbrook asked to have the agenda amended to include the first reading of board policies 2271 Dual Enrollment, 5460 Graduation Requirements, and 2271.01 Weighted Grade Policy.

Ms. Shanabrook moved, Ms. Brenner seconded a motion to approve the Agenda of the Regular Board of Education meeting being held Monday, March 19<sup>th</sup>, 2007, as amended. Motion passed 7-0.

**Approval of Consent Agenda**

Ms. Chamberlain moved, Ms. Brenner seconded a motion to adopt the Consent Agenda as presented. Motion passed 7-0.

**Presentations:**

Ms. Janet Yachim from Ingham Intermediate School District presented the 2006-2007 revised budget.

**Reports:**

Policy – Ms. Westbrook stated that there were action items that had been added to the agenda. We are waiting for changes from NEOLA for the second half of '06. There is now a list of performance enhancing drugs that are illegal drugs and medications and this list will be posted in the locker rooms.

Finance – Ms. Brenner stated that Ms. Yachim had presented the revised budget and we would be approving that as an action item. The committee is also working on the '07-'08 budget and will present at the June meeting.

Building and Grounds – Ms. Chamberlain stated that they would be scheduling a meeting in the near future.

Personnel – Ms. Shanabrook stated that she would be meeting with the committee soon as there is an issue that needs to be addressed.

Legislation – Ms. Westbrook stated that there was no report.

ISOA – Ms. Brenner reviewed the Legislative breakfast. She stated that the MASB has made presentations to Certified Board Members. President Simmons presented Ms. Westbrook her Level One Certification and Merit Award from MASB.

Superintendent – Dr. Skilling highlighted the following items: Scholarships, Memorial Day Remembrance, The Elementary Blue Ribbon Assembly, the Governors Town Hall meeting, Lest the be Forgotten Webberville Memorial Day Fun Run.

Brian Friddle talked about Internationalizing American Education and the possibilities of student going to foreign countries for study.

### **Action Items:**

Ms. Westbrook provided the first reading of Policy #2271 and #5460. Policy #2271 and #5460 were discussed for review.

Mr. Miller moved, Ms. Guidroz seconded a motion to approve the Michigan Blue Ribbon Exemplary School Resolution in honor of Webberville Elementary School. Motion passed 7-0.

Ms. Westbrook presented the first reading of board policy 2271 Dual Enrollment, 5450 Graduation Requirements, and 2271.01 Weighted Grade Policy. Motion passed 7-0.

### **Question or Comments from the Audience:**

Mr. Paul Oesterle congratulated the Elementary School on their Blue Ribbon program. He was very impressed with the students who spoke at the program. He said that everyone is to be complimented.

Rainey Bohlman asked if the Alternative Ed students had the same standards for graduation. Dr. Skilling stated that they do, but there are just in a different learning environment.

Kathe Pierman asked Ms. Westbrook she had the number of high schools that offered weighted classes. Ms. Westbrook said that she didn't know off hand and could get that info.

Julia McCarty has questions on what was considered a full-time student and does it still allow flexibility in scheduling. Ms. Westbrook stated that we only receive full funding for full time students. Ms. Westbrook will check with legal on

whether or not a student can be required to take classes their senior year if they have met the graduation requirements.

Ms. Westbrook asked about the Special Education report and the funding to cover a specific student for the following year.
