Policy – The second reading of policy 6620 will be on the agenda. Policy volume 33, number 2 will also be on the agenda for the first reading. These policies have been reviewed by the committee and Dr. Halik.

Personnel – Teachers Mary Beth Glover and Cathy Fitzgerald have retired. Wanda Lewis has retired as the secondary guidance counselor. Candidates have been selected for approval on Monday night. We will also be hiring a school psychologist. Currently other positions to be filled include the secondary front office and special education. Mary Roscoe, daycare worker, passed away unexpectedly on June 4.

Buildings and Grounds – The baseball fields will be receiving some updates this summer. Renovation of the new elementary office has started. We anticipate the office and the new vestibule door will be completed by the end of the summer. Myers Plumbing was the only company to provide a bid for the new boiler and the approval to move forward will be an action item on Monday night. The items supported by the MSP grant are being implemented and should be completed by early fall if not before.

Other – Pending items moving forward are the approval of new textbooks for science and English, the superintendent's evaluation, and the school photography contract.
