Mr. Friddle stated the administration will survey families about one-on-one usage of devices for instruction. Ms. Aaron Mayes offered to compile device use and participation this spring for her classroom. Mr. Friddle announced there will be a drive-in for the elementary on Friday night to bring closure for the end of the school year for the elementary students, and there will be an awards ceremony for seniors at 7:30 PM in the parking lot behind the Spartan Center.

Ms. Coe reminded board members to review the superintendent's evaluation information in preparation for the next meeting. There was discussion about options for a commencement ceremony, and additional discussion about preparing for the delivery of education in the fall.
