



NEW STUDENT – 22e PLACEMENT

PREVIOUS ENROLLMENT IN SPECIAL EDUCATION

The Revised Administrative Rules for Special Education (June 6, 2002) provides for the temporary delivery of special education programs and services under certain conditions.

Administrative Rule 340.1722e

- (1) If a student who currently receives special education programs or services enrolls in a new school district, then the new school district shall do either of the following:
 - (a) With the parent's consent, immediately implement the student's current individualized educational program.
 - (b) With the parent's consent, immediately place the student into an appropriate program or service and convene an individualized educational program team meeting within 30 school days to develop an individualized education program.

- (2) If the parent does not provide consent for placement, then the school district will implement the student's current individualized educational program to the extent possible and an individualized educational program team meeting shall be convened as soon as possible, but not later than 30 school days.

Parent/Guardian Consent

I give my consent under Rule 22e 1 (a) or 1 (b) to either implement my child's current individualized educational program or place my child into an appropriate program or service and convene an individualized educational program team meeting within 30 school days to develop an individualized educational program.
