RESOLUTION FOR ADOPTION BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF WEBBERVILLE COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

GENERAL FUND

RESOLVED, that this resolution shall be the general appropriations act of Webberville Community Schools for the fiscal year 2018-2019; AN ACT to make appropriations; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to provide for the disposition of all income received by Webberville Community Schools.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total revenues, which include 18.0 mills of ad valorem property taxes to be levied on non-homestead property, and unappropriated fund balance estimated to be available for appropriations in the General Fund of the Webberville Community Schools for fiscal year 2018-2019 are as follows:

FURTHER RESOLVED, that no Board of Education member or employee of the school district shall expend any funds or obligate the expenditure of any funds except pursuant to appropriations made by by the Board of Education and in keeping with the budgetary policy statement hitherto adopted by the Board. Changes in the amount appropriated by the Board shall require approval by the Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Superintendent is hereby charged with general supervision of the execution of the budget adopted by the Board and shall hold the department heads responsible for performance of their responsibilities within the amounts appropriated by the Board of Education and in keeping with the budgetary policy statement hitherto adopted by the Board.

This act is to take effect immediately.
